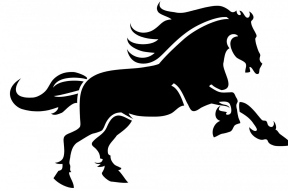

SUBJ: Harry Potter Reading Challenge for January

Harry Potter and Order of the Phoenix is the challenge for January. Classes participating are 3rd-12th. Third to sixth grade students can use this book toward their class goal. The celebration of the 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Harry Potter series is continuing by reading and doing the activities for the remaining books by the end of March. The activities for Book 5 are:

## **Harry Potter and the Order of the Phoenix (Book 5) Read and Activities Completed by Feb. 4**

Activity 1: In a Google document, discuss the significance of what Harry learns about his father and Sirius, Lupin, and Pettigrew from Snape's memory in the Pensieve. How does this knowledge affect Harry? What does this tell us about Harry's character?

Compare the relationship of James and his friends in their school days to that of Ron, Hermione, and Harry. How are they similar and how are they different? Share to Mrs. Northup.

Activity 2: Send Mrs. Northup a paragraph in a Google document with the life lesson you learned from the fifth book and how you can apply it to your life. The double-spaced paragraph should have six to seven sentences.

Activity 3: Take AR Quiz--must pass with 70% or higher.

Mrs. Northup will be sending information to the students who qualify for the movie for the fourth book, Harry Potter and the Goblet of Fire. We will plan on Thursday, January 17 for the movie in the library from 4:00-6:30 p.m. More information coming shortly to the qualifying students
